


QUICK START

"Assemble your clock movement to your clock case and turn the time setting knob slowly until you hear a "click" sound where is the 12:00 o'clock position. (Fig. 2)

"Insert the hour hand, minute hand, minute screw nut and second hand on the 12:00 o'clock position. (Fig.3) "Install three alkaline type AA batteries into the battery compartments (one for the clock movement and two for the chime unit).

Set the S2 switch on the 24H position and set the S1 either on 1 or 2.

* Set the hour and minute according to your local time and the clock will work correctly.



TO DEMONSTRATE AND SYNCHRONIZE THE STRIKE

This is controlled by pushing the PLAY button. PLAY serves two functions: chime demonstration and strike setting. Both of these functions can be activated in any operating mode.

a.) Demonstration-A short press and release of PLAY will demonstrate the melody followed by a number of strikes which is currently memorized in the electronic circuit. Note that the press on the PLAY has to be a short one which will not exceed 2 seconds. If the press is longer than 2 seconds, then the clock will enter the Strike set mode.

 b.) Strike setting-After a battery change or installation. the clock must be set so that the number of strikes is the same as the hour reading of the clock. This is done by pushing and holding down PLAY until a short beep is heard. Release the button and count the number of strikes. This number is equal to the value currently stored in the memory of the electronic circuit. Within 4 seconds after the last strike has sounded, short presses on PLAY will advance the strike by one for each press.(Each press is identified by a short beep.) Apply the correct number of presses so that the number of strikes synchronizes with the hour shown in the clock. For the purpose of setting the strikes it is necessary to differentiate between morning and afternoon time. A 24-hour day system like that appears in airline flight. timetables is used. The number of strikes goes from one to 24 (for 12 o'clock mid night) and recycles to one, two etc. If the clock is set to the afternoon time add 12 to the hour(for example, the reading in the clock is 4:45 pm. the number of strike to set should be 16 (=12+4)). When the clock is running the chime will strike the same as the hour shown in the clock. (Note: 24-hour mode is for setting only, for normal running the number of strikes works according to 12 hour day system).

Note: If the PLAY key has not been pressed for more than 4 seconds from the last strike then the clock will exit the strike set mode by giving out a beep to indicate the exit.

For example: The current reading on the clock is 4:45 pm (which is 16:45 hours in 24-hour day system. This means to set the strike to sound 16 times in set mode). First a long press is applied to PLAY and release on hearing a beep. Six strikes are then heard. Within 4 seconds after the 6° strike,10 short presses are applied to PLAY and 16 strikes are heard after releasing PLAY. The strike is now synchronized.

BATTERIES

This clock operates on three alkaline type AA size batteries. Replace the batteries when the sound becomes weak or if the clock loses time.

TO SELECT THE MELODY OR RECORDING VOICE

Use sliding switch S1 to select the chime melody. Position by is for Whittington and position by is for Westminster and position by is for recording voice.

Note: Hourly strike is only for Whittington and Westminster. Recording voice has no hourly strike.

TO SELECT 24-HOUR ROUND-THE-CLOCK CHIME OR NIGHT SILENCE

The clock can be set to sound every hour throughout the 24 hours of the day or silenced after the 10:00 pm strike and start again at 6:00 am in the next morning. This selection is done by the S2 switch. Move S2 to 24H position to activate the "24-hour" strike mode and move S2 to 'Zz' position to activate night silence function.

TO STOP THE CHIME AND STRIKES COMPLETELY

Move slide switch S2 to > position.

TO RECORD VOICE

Press RECORD and speak through the built in MIC phone or connect with the external MIC phone .The LED will flash for 10 seconds and then recording.

TO CONTROL THE VOLUME

Turn VOLUME CONTROL BUTTON left for small volume. Turn VOLUME CONTROL BUTTON right for large volume.
