
Key terms

Autosome: Chromosome that is not involved in determining the sex of an individual. Humans have 23 pairs of chromosomes made up of 22 pairs of autosomes and one pair of sex chromosomes.

Crossing over: Exchange of alleles between non-sister chromatids (replicated copies of chromosomes of a homologous pair) during meiosis 1.

Sex chromosomes: The pair of chromosomes that determines whether an individual is male (XY) or female (XX). These chromosomes may also contain genes for other characteristics that are therefore sex-linked.

Non-sister chromatids have swapped alleles

These chromatids contain new combinations of alleles. If two gametes containing recombinants combine at fertilisation, plants with pink flowers and long seed pods or purple flowers and short seed pods may appear in the F2 generation
