The Song of Songs in the Middle Ages Ann W. Astell, 2018-10-18 Included among the sacred books of Judaism and Christianity alike, the Song of Songs does not mention God at all. According to Astell, these commentaries present Canticles as a marriage song that mirrors a series of analogous marriages, both within the individual and between human and divine persons. Astell describes interpretations of the Song of Songs in terms of the various feminine archetypes that the expositors emphasize: the Virgin Mother, the Hetaira, or the Medium. She maintains that the commentators encourage the auditor's identification with the figure of the Bride so as to evoke and direct the feminine affective powers of the soul. Turning to literature influenced by the Song, she then discusses how the reading process is reinscribed in selected works in Middle English, including Richard Rolle's autobiographical writings, Pearl, religious love lyrics, and cycle dramas. *The Song of Songs in the Middle Ages* provides an innovative model of reader response that opens the way for a deeper understanding of the literary influence of biblical texts.
