

Structure of the Periodontium



Periodontal Terminology

- Free ginglus/Unattached ginglus the border of the ginglus the surrounds the teeth in a collar-like fashion.
- Attached gingara extends from the base of the suicus to the mucogingival junction. It is a stippled, dense
 tissue that is self-protecting, firmly bound & resilient
- Periodontal ligament a group of specialized connective tissue fibers that attach the tooth to the alveolar bone within which it sits. It inserts into root comentum one side & onto the alveolar bone on the other.
- Interdental papillae part of the gingiva that exists coronal to the free gingival margin on the buccal & lingual tarriace of teeth

Prevalence of Periodontal Diseases

- · Periodontal disease is the leading cause of tooth loss in adults
- Almost 75% of American adults have some form of periodontal disease, & most are unaware of the condition.
- · Almost all adults & many children have calculus on their teeth

The Systemic Connection

- Chronic inflammatory periodontal disease may significantly affect health conditions such as coronary heart disease, stroke,/preterm birth
 - · Chronic inflammation appears to do harm to the entire body
- Certain systemic conditions increase the patient's susceptibility to periodontal disease
 - Periodontal disease may actually increase a patient's susceptibility to certain systemic conditions
- Cardiovascular disease
 - Individuals w/ periodontal disease have a greater incidence of coronary heart disease.
- · Preterm low birth weight
 - · Women w/ severe periodontal disease have 7x the risk of PLBW infants.
- Respiratory disease
 - · Individuals w/ periodontal disease may be (6) increased risk for respiratory infection.
