- Before birth: fetal right to left shunt
 - a. Alveoli = expanded and filled with FLUID not air

 - Placenta supplies O2 to the fetus + CO2 is carried into the mother
 - Most blood bypasses the fetal lungs through 2 openings = right to left shunt
 - Most highly oxygenated blood goes to the brain + heart
 - e. Pulmonary vessels are tightly constricted = high pulmonary resistance
 - After birth
 - At birth: first breaths help move fluid out of the airways
 - i. Fill with air provides enough O2 (21%) to relax and dilate pulmonary blood vessels
 - b. As blood flows and O2 level increases 2 heart openings for fetal circulation start to close = resolves right to left shunt
 - c. Blood and O2 can now flow as expected
 - Newborn resuscitation = respiratory failure before or after birth, lungs not ventilated, prolonged lack of adequate perfusion and oxygenation = organ damage or death
 - Newborn = cannot resuscitate until the lungs are INFLATED
 - Very few require chest compressions or meds
 - Ventilation of the lungs = MOST important and effective step in neonatal resuscitation
 - d. Need to know how to provide PPV
 - Assess perinatal risk BEFORE birth to identify which newborns will most likely need resuscitation (can get the correct people + equipment ready beforehand)
 - Perinatal risk factors
 - <36 weeks or >41 weeks
 - ii. Preeclampsia/HTN
 - iii. Multiple gestation
 - iv. Fetal anemia
 - Fetal macrosomia
 - vi. Intrauterine growth restriction
 - vii. Fetal malformations/anomalies
 - viii. No prenatal care
 - ix. Emergency C-section
