- In the second part, this book consists of seven chapters, among others:
 - A. In the chapter Basics of individual behavior, it is explained about the types of individual abilities, the main biographical characteristics, how to understand ways to shape the behavior of others, and also classify the role of punishment in learning. The conclusion is that all observable changes in behavior are direct evidence that learning has occurred. Knowledge of learning further suggests that reinforcement is a more effective tool than punishment. Punishment can have unpleasant side effects such as lower morale and higher absenteeism or turnover.
 - B. Attitudes and Job Satisfaction discussed the differences in the 3 attitude components:
 - Role consistent in attitude,
 - The relationship between attitudes and behavior,
 - The similarities and differences between job satisfaction and other work attitudes are
 discussed, the main causes of job satisfaction and the four employee responses to
 dissatisfaction. From this chapter it can be concluded that to increase employee job
 satisfaction, is to focus on the intrinsic parts of the job, such as making the job more
 challenging and interesting.
 - C. Personality and Values are explained about the factors that determine an individual's personality, the Myers Briggs type indicator personality framework, the main traits in the big five personality model, the main personality traits can predict behavior in the place

Work, terminal and instrumental values, the dominant values of today's workforce and the five dimensions of national cultural values by Hofstede. In this chapter it can be concluded that the work performance and satisfaction of employees tend to be higher when their values are very compatible with the organization.

D. Perception and Individual Decision Making explained how two people can see the same thing and interpret it differently, three relationship determinants, shortcuts that help or change our judgments about other people, perceptions that influence the decisionmaking process, six rational steps in the model decision making, the actions of rational decision makers, common decision mistakes, conditions in which individuals are most

The success of agile leadership depends on factors like a company's culture industry and size and this can be studied further Furthermore organizations may need to adjust their strategies on customer service financial management and investment so that they better reflect the values of agile leadership ORIGINALITY AND VALUE This study classifies numerous different research models that shed light on the efficiency of agile

leadership based on a comprehensive literature review that serves as the basis for this study.
