
EXAMPLE 6:-



Identify the unknowns:-

At A:- Va, Ha, Ma

At E:- VE (if E is a roller). HE and VE (if E is a pin).

As there is no horizontal applied loading on the beam, HA and HE are zero.

2. Identify the knowns:-

At A:- $\theta_A = 0$; $\Delta_A = 0$.

Since $\theta_A = 0$, use the fixed end A as Mohr's reference point.

At E:- θ_E is unknown; $\Delta_E = 0$.

Since θε is not equal to 0, we cannot use E as Mohr's reference point. Mohr's reference must be a point of zero slope.

Therefore, make VE the unknown reaction.

3. $\Delta \epsilon = 0$.

Therefore, apply Mohr's theorem for deflection to solve VE

MOHR'S 2^{NO} THEOREM (DISPLACEMENT) IS ALWAYS USED TO SOLVE THE UNKNOWN VERTICAL REACTION AT THE PROPPED END OF A PROPPED CANTILEVER BEAM.
