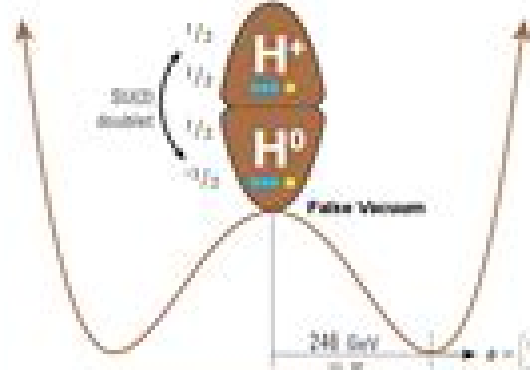

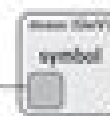

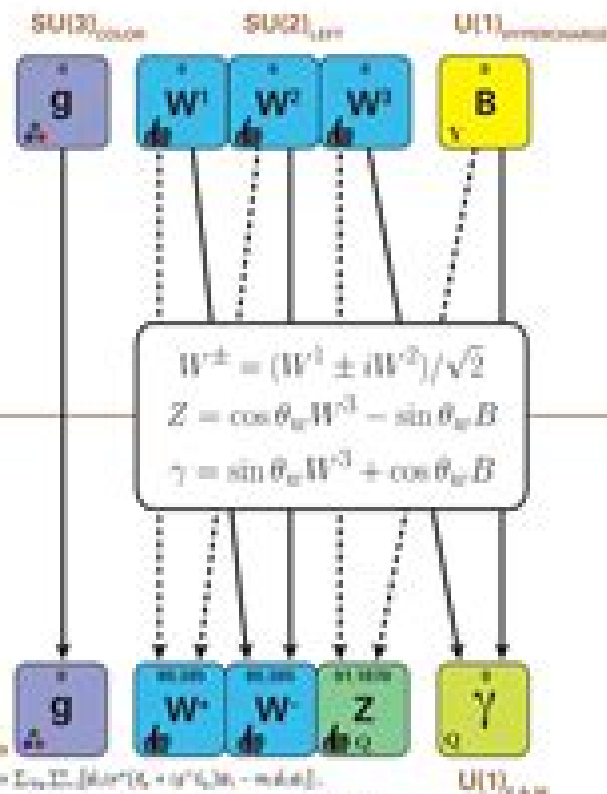

To students: You cannot start to do problems without previous studying your lecture notes and textbooks. Try to solve problems without using solutions; they should help you to check your results. The level of this Problem Book corresponds to the textbooks of Mandl and Shaw [15], Greiner and Reinhardt [11] and Peskin and Schroeder [16]. Each Chapter begins with a short introduction aimed to define notation. The first Chapter is devoted to the Lorentz and Poincaré symmetries. Chapters 2, 3 and 4 deal with the relativistic quantum mechanics with a special emphasis on the Dirac equation. In Chapter 5 we present problems related to the Euler-Lagrange equations and the Noether theorem.
