Behaviorist: argues that perception is not automatically interpreting external input; learned motor capabilities and motivational programs describe strategies in perceptual development

- learn with basic sensory capabilities, reflect according to what plan

- perception is direct and does not require processing

Gibson's ecological theory: information: perception is directly and directly available in the environment

- perception reflects action

- more natural and intuitive an interpretation

Adaptation: when the object has an effect on and how it might be used by us

- what something affects regarding our perceptual capabilities

6.2 The Infant

William: infants showed that sight, touch, and other sensory input form a hierarchy; learning contributes for the infant

- what is learned: young infants have greater perceptual capabilities than infants' caregivers and naturally learn to do so
