Response

A single, specific reation to a stimulus Ex. A tiger attacking its prey.

Behavior

The way an organism reacts to changes in its internal condition or external environment. Ex. Turning your head in the direction of noise, washing dishes.

Innate behavior or inborn behavior

Appear in fully funcional form the first time they are performed, even though the animal doesn't had provious experience

Imprinting

when young animals learn to recognize and follow their mother. Involves innate and learned behavior

Learned behavior or acquired behavior

This mehavior develops over time

major types of learning

Insight learning

Occurs when an animal applies something it has already learned to a new situation, without a period of trial and error.

Habituation

Process by which an animal decreases or stops its response

Operant Conditioning

Occurs when an animal learns to behave in a certain way through repeated practice, in order to receive a reward or avoid punishment.

Classical Conditioning

Any time an animal makes a mental connection between a stimulus and some kind of reward or punishment.
