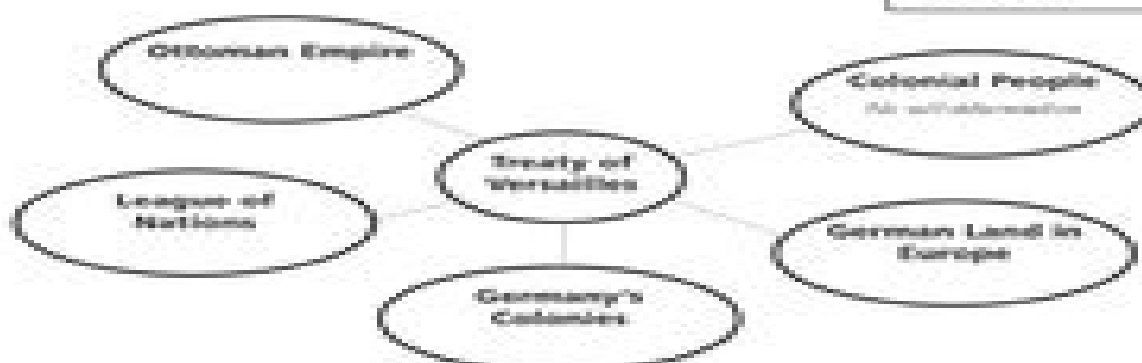

What decisions were made at Versailles?

Many nations sent delegates to the peace talks in Paris. The main leaders were **Woodrow Wilson** of the United States, **Georges Clemenceau** of France, and **David Lloyd George** of Britain. Germany and its allies and Russia were not present.

Wilson pushed for his peace plan called the **Fourteen Points**. He wanted to end secret treaties

and alliances and give people **self-determination**, the right to form their own nations. He also hoped to set up a world organization that would police the actions of nations and prevent future wars.

Britain and especially France had different views. They had suffered greatly in the war. They wanted to punish Germany. After long debates, the leaders finally agreed on a peace settlement. It was called the **Treaty of Versailles** and was signed in June 1919.

The treaty called for a **League of Nations**, the world organization that Wilson wanted. It would include 32 nations. The United States,

The second part then explores the fundamentals of the social psychological aspects of ethnic conflicts reflected upon so well by Herbert Kelman who builds upon Burton's research concerning the dimension of deep rooted conflicts as ethical conflicts usually can be described emphasising human needs and fears over interests since they can be seen as the root cause for the inadequacy of Zartman's theory of the ripe moment. Moreover the concept of work shops designed by Kelman as a feature of track II diplomacy in conflict resolution shall serve as a successful example for an alternative in a long term approach to peace processes. Altogether it is to notice that the paper is based on the constructivist assumption of the ethnic concept in contrast to the primordialist thought. Furthermore Zartman's ripe moment should not in anyway be discredited in its contribution to conflict resolution as it can serve as a valuable turning point. However it should not be seen as the solution but rather as an initial accompanying step in a long term process that is essential for a sustainable peace. Finally when taking these considerations in mind the core element needed in addition for a successful peace process is political and societal will in order to really overcome no war no peace situations on the long term.

Situations of serious or massive violations of human rights are no longer purely of domestic concern and sovereignty can no longer be an absolute shield for repressive governments in such circumstances.
