

Mountains are tall landforms. A mountain is a large area of land that rises high above the ground. There are a few mountains on Earth that stand alone, but most mountains are grouped with other mountains. A group of mountains is called a **RANGE**. Mount Everest is the highest mountain on Earth. It is about 29,000 feet high.


More About MOUNTAINS!



Many mountains have steep sides and colder weather than lower areas of land. The main reason for this is that mountains are high above the ground. It is more common for low mountains used for **RECREATION**. This means people like to have fun and do activities on mountains, such as skiing, hiking, and mountain climbing.
