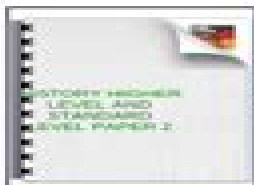

Zimbabwe: The Link Between Politics and the Economy Godfrey Kanyenze, 2022-03-31 In this accessible and authoritative book Godfrey Kanyenze provides a comprehensive and far reaching analysis of the socio economic development in Zimbabwe in light of the expanding authoritarianism and the ongoing destruction of democratic institutions during the four decades after independence Kanyenze describes the various phases of the socio economic development starting with 1980 when the people of Zimbabwe saw their hard won independence and new democracy as a promise for a better life for all Kanyenze highlights how by dismantling all barriers of economic and legal restraint and that despite being necessary The land reform programme put the political and financial interests of the elite before those of the people which continues to this day Kanyenze reveals the governmental attacks on civil society and notes how economic policy was not even part of an authoritarian bargain an implicit arrangement between ruling elites and citizens whereby citizens relinquish political freedom in exchange for public goods And he concludes this analysis with a current update of Zimbabwe today where citizens have nothing neither political freedom nor public goods This impressive and gripping account of an authoritarian capitalist system and a country in decline is a must read for students researchers policymakers and those who want to better understand how politics and the economy interests conflicts and power work together The Return of Food Tawodzera, Godfrey, Crush, Jonathan, 2016-06-14 The nadir of Zimbabwe's political and economic crisis in 2008 coincided with the implementation of a baseline household food security survey in Harare by AFSUN This survey found that households in low income urban areas in Zimbabwe's capital were far worse off in terms of all the food insecurity and poverty indicators than households in the other 10 Southern African cities surveyed by AFSUN The central question addressed in this report is whether food security in Zimbabwe's urban centres has improved AFSUN conducted a follow up survey in 2012 that allows for direct longitudinal comparisons of continuity and change The status of household food security in low income neighbourhoods in Harare was improved in 2012 relative to 2008 and yet persistently high rates of severe food insecurity demonstrate that the daily need to access adequate food continued to be a major challenge The key lesson for policymakers is that even in the context of overall economic improvement food insecurity remains endemic among the poorest segments of the urban population Households are already accustomed to drawing on resources outside of the formal economy and improvements in employment income have not reversed that trend These alternative livelihood strategies should therefore be considered as a normal part of urban life and supported with state resources that can improve access to food for the most marginalized groups *The Politics of the Dead in Zimbabwe, 2000-2020* Joost Fontein, 2022 Innovative and challenging study that provides fresh insights on the anthropology of death and postcolonial politics In 1898 just before she was hanged for rebelling against colonial rule Charwe Nyakasikana spirit medium of the legendary ancestor Ambuya Nehanda famously prophesised that my bones will rise again A century later bones bodies and human remains have come to occupy an

increasingly complex place in Zimbabwe's postcolonial milieu. Linking the indeterminacy of human substances to the productive but precarious uncertainties of rumours and spirits, the book points to how the incompleteness of death is politically productive and ultimately derives from the problematic entangled excessivities of human material and immaterial existence and is deeply intertwined with the stylistics of postcolonial power and politics. Joost Fontein is Professor of Anthropology, University of Johannesburg. He was previously Director of the British Institute in Eastern Africa and Lecturer in Social Anthropology at the University of Edinburgh. Zimbabwe's Military: Examining its Veto Power in the Transition to Democracy, 2008-2013 (Rupiya, Martin R., 2013-10-14). Political transition and democratisation challenges have been noted in African countries including Angola, Burkina Faso, Kenya, Mali and the Democratic Republic of the Congo, resulting in the African Union (AU) intervening on behalf of citizens using tried and tested mechanisms of imposing a power sharing agreement to preside over a transitional period during which there are key changes to the constitution and the political conduct of the incumbency and partisan institutions are weaned from seeking to perpetuate the status quo. This book focuses on Zimbabwe's military and its perceived veto power in the transition to democratisation from 2008 until 2013. The objective was to analyse, monitor and comment on the unique democratic transformational challenges faced by Zimbabwe's Government of National Unity. One of the book's key findings is that every time partisan forces carry out an operation in the name of a political party, there is a direct correlation in which the same loses its national character. This is the context of the challenge facing Zimbabwean forces when used for partisan gain and why the Southern African Development Community (SADC) in its last communique in Maputo on 15 June 2013 sought to compel a written undertaking from the generals that they would desist from playing a direct role in the politics of the country. The AU had earlier expressed its deep regret when faced with the results of serious human rights abuses that were committed with impunity.
