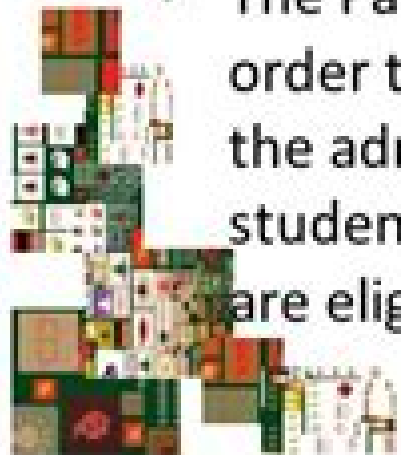


PREAMBLE

- NSFAS was established in terms of the NSFAS Act, No.56 of 1999 to provide financial aid to eligible students who meet the criteria for admission to a **higher education** programme.
- Section 20 of the NSFAS Act authorises NSFAS to enter into agreements with designated **higher education institutions** for the purpose of administering loans and bursaries to students of that institution on behalf of NSFAS.
- The Parties therefore seek to enter into an Agreement in order to regulate their roles and responsibilities in relation to the administration of loans and bursaries granted by NSFAS to students of that designated **higher education institution** who are eligible for financial aid.
