What can we do?

Policy interventions can address poverty and inequality.

1. INCREASE THE MINIMUM WAGE

A federal minimum wage increase to \$10.10 would lift 4.5 million people out of poverty.



That would be equivalent to the total population of Louisiana.

2. AUGMENT AND IMPROVE THE EARNED INCOME TAX CREDIT (EITC)

In recent years, the tax credit's impact on families has lifted roughly 4.7 million children above the poverty line annually. This has also correlated with:



Improvements in maternal and infant health.



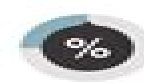
Higher cognitive achievement in children.

3. IMPLEMENT TAX REFORM MEASURES

Capital gains tax rates should be commensurate with income tax and payroll tax rates, so that the wealthy pay the same tax rate as everyone else.

4. INVEST IN EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION

Areas with higher mean test scores and lower high school dropout rates display higher rates of economic mobility.



5. BUILD ASSETS AND WEALTH FOR LOWER- AND MIDDLE- INCOME AMERICANS

Homeownership remains a crucial pathway for building intergenerational wealth. There should be sustainable lending terms, rather than restrictions on first-time buyers' opportunity to invest in a home by providing credit on affordable terms.



A large portion of the home interest mortgage deduction currently functions as a subsidy for the wealthy and should be reformed to serve those who need it most.

The home interest mortgage deduction totals ~\$40 billion.

60% of the subsidy goes to households with income >\$75,000.

6. SUPPORT NEIGHBORHOOD AND SCHOOL ECONOMIC AND RACIAL INTEGRATION

Areas that are less segregated by race and class correlate with increased economic mobility.
