what the right to die looks like in practice it also provides insights on the slippery slope argument which serves as a counterweight to personal autonomy without making a definitive statement on its validity This part also illustrates the different paths that led or did not lead to the right to die in practice The second part is an analysis of the European Court of Human Rights case law on the right to die The Court has made important statements in only very cases while its caution when approaching such a delicate and controversial topic among its 47 members is understandably emphasized This analysis of the Court s approach to the balancing of personal autonomy against other interests allows us to take a look back at the practice in more permissive jurisdictions through the lens of the Convention Taken together the book s two parts provide valuable lessons for countries that decide to practice assisted dying which are outlined in the conclusion In addition given that a purely legal approach can only offer a partial picture the book argues that an interdisciplinary approach would be much more favorable in terms of providing the necessary basis for the right to die debate
