



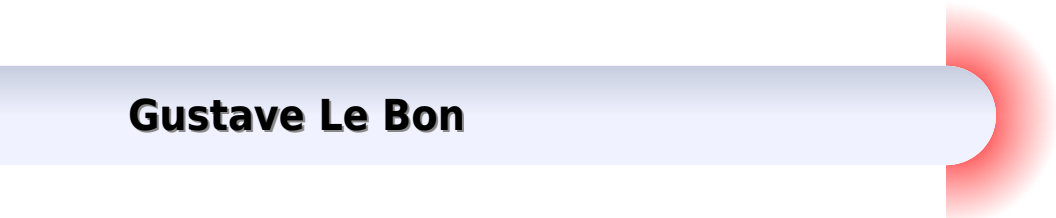

constructs his portrait revealing surprising parallels between the political representation of the people in government and their aesthetic representation in painting Both essentially frame the people Jonsson argues defining them as elites or masses responsible citizens or angry mobs Yet in the aesthetic fantasies of David Ensor and Jaar Jonsson finds a different understanding of democracy one in which human collectives break the frame and enter the picture Connecting the achievements and failures of past revolutions to current political issues Jonsson then situates our present moment in a long historical drama of popular unrest making his book both a cultural history and a contemporary discussion about the fate of democracy in our globalized world

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
