Briefly suggest how Marcus might use the three behaviours that you have identified in your answer to Q1.1 to persuade his friends to go travelling. **[3 marks]**

0 2 Ten A-level students took part in a study of attitudes to Milgram's research on obedience. They were asked about the value of Milgram's research and about ethical concerns with Milgram's research.

For each student, the researcher recorded two scores out of 10, a 'value of research' score and an 'ethical concern' score.

A high 'value of research' score means the student thinks Milgram's research was very valuable and a high 'ethical concern' score means that the student thinks that Milgram's research caused many ethical concerns.

The findings are shown in Table 1 below.
