- Complete history and physical examination
- Detailed neurovascular examination (note axillary nerve function by setting the deltoid)
 - o When function is unclear: repeat exam after several weeks, or Electromyography (EMG) is helpful
- Imaging
 - o Grashey, Axillary, and Scapular-Y radiographs
 - Computed tomography with or without 3-dimensional reconstruction may provide more information if deciding between RSA and ORIF. May identify additional pathology such as a concomitant glenoid fracture.
 - o Magnetic resonance imaging has little additional benefit
- Fracture Classification
 - Neer Classification (29) has low inter and intraobserver reliability (91), but is primary clinical classification system
 - o Arbeitsgemeinschaft für Osteosynthesefragen (AO) Classification
- Initial Treatment
 - Sling or hanging arm cast
 - o Non weight bearing affected extremity
