Situation

In 2012, Excent/lobil proposed the next generation air compressor oil, Mobil SHC** Rarus 68 as a candidate trial oil in a Kaeser DS 170 rotary screw compressor for a period of 2 years. The purpose of the trial was to assess the performance of Mobil Rarus SHC 68 against the current product in use, for productivity improvement and extended oil drain interval. Previously, the compressor was using ISO VG68 synthetic oil and the Oil Drain Interval (OOI) was 6,000 hours. The system was flushed to minimize commingling between the current oil and test oil. As part of the Mobil Planned Engineering Service (PES) program, the used oil samples are collected on regular intervals and sent to the Mobil Signum** laboratory for analysis.
