

2S Reproductive Systems study guide:

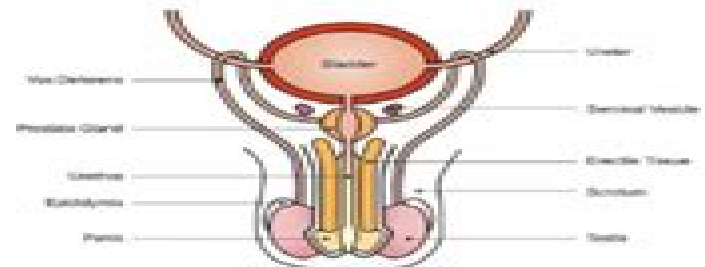
● Female:

- **Main goal:** to release hormones and produce female sex cells
- The female sex cells are called **ovum (eggs)**
- Hormones closely related to the female reproductive system:
estrogen
 - During adolescence – this causes changes in puberty (growth of breast muscle, release of first eggs, otherwise known as the menstrual cycle, widening of hips)
 - Cause the reproductive organs to mature
- **Organs:** ovaries, fallopian tubes, uterus, vagina
 - Each ovary contains the limited number of eggs a woman has (she is born with this number)
 - One egg is released per month in a process called menstruation
 - This is a process which lasts around 28 days
 - The lining of the uterus will shed for 3 – 7 days if no ovum has been fertilized by sperm, it will be released from the body



● Male:

- **Main goal:** producing sperm and male hormones (testosterone)
- The male sex cell is the **sperm**
- During adolescence, testosterone causes
 - Causes most of the changes due to puberty such as growth of body hair and deepening of voice
 - Causes maturing and growth of reproductive system



Human development:

1. **Fetus** – development inside the uterus of the mother (gestation of 40 weeks)
2. **Infant** – Up to 1 year of age
3. **Childhood** – 1 – 11 year old
4. **Adolescence** – Changes in puberty occurs, can happen anytime between 8 – 14 years of age (on average), Girls' growth spurts are between 8-12 years and growth gradually declines until age 17 or 18. Boys begin their growth spurt between 10-15 years. Growth peaks between 14.5-15.5 years with growth gradually declining until age 20 or 21.
5. **Adulthood** – longest stage of human development 18 – until old age and eventually, death.
