 - Biologically programmed to follow first object they see because it is adaptive
 - Nature/nurture? Nature
 - Active/passive? Passive
 - Continuous/discontinuous? Discontinuous (due to early critical period)
 - Learning Perspective: Emphasize experience in child development (agree with Locke's idea of "tabula rasa")
 - i. John Watson-behaviorism/learning perspective
 - Learning determines child development (**experience)
 - Nature/nurture? Nurture
 - Active/passive? Passive
 - Continuous/discontinuous? Continuous
 - ii. B.F. Skinner—operant conditioning
 - Emphasizes role of reinforcement and punishment (behavioral consequences determine behavior)
 - Reinforcement: consequences that increase future likelihood of a behavior
 - i. Positive reinforcement=giving reward
 - ii. Negative reinforcement=taking away something unpleasant
 - Punishment: consequences that decrease future likelihood of a behavior
 - BUT limited because children also learn by imitation or observational learning (Bandura)
 - iii. Bandura—social cognitive theory
 - Emphasizes children's efforts to understand their world, using reinforcement, punishment, and other's behavior
