The History of Literature in Wei, Jin, Southern and Northern Dynasty
 Li Shi, The book is the volume of The History of Literature in Wei Jin Southern and Northern Dynasty among a series of books of Deep into China Histories The earliest known written records of the history of China date from as early as 1250 BC from the Shang dynasty c 1600 1046 BC and the Bamboo Annals 296 BC describe a Xia dynasty c 2070 1600 BC before the Shang but no writing is known from the period The Shang ruled in the Yellow River valley which is commonly held to be the cradle of Chinese civilization However Neolithic civilizations originated at various cultural centers along both the Yellow River and Yangtze River These Yellow River and Yangtze civilizations arose millennia before the Shang With thousands of years of continuous history China is one of the world's oldest civilizations and is regarded as one of the cradles of civilization The Zhou dynasty 1046 256 BC supplanted the Shang and introduced the concept of the Mandate of Heaven to justify their rule The central Zhou government began to weaken due to external and internal pressures in the 8th century BC and the country eventually splintered into smaller states during the Spring and Autumn period These states became independent and warred with one another in the following Warring States period Much of traditional Chinese culture literature and philosophy first developed during those troubled times In 221 BC Qin Shi Huang conquered the various warring states and created for himself the title of Huangdi or emperor of the Qin marking the beginning of imperial China However the oppressive government fell soon after his death and was supplanted by the longer lived Han dynasty 206 BC 220 AD Successive dynasties developed bureaucratic systems that enabled the emperor to control vast territories directly In the 21 centuries from 206 BC until AD 1912 routine administrative tasks were handled by a special elite of scholar officials Young men well versed in calligraphy history literature and philosophy were carefully selected through difficult government examinations China's last dynasty was the Qing 1644 1912 which was replaced by the Republic of China in 1912 and in the mainland by the People's Republic of China in 1949 Chinese history has alternated between periods of political unity and peace and periods of war and failed statehood the most recent being the Chinese Civil War 1927 1949 China was occasionally dominated by steppe peoples most of whom were eventually assimilated into the Han Chinese culture and population Between eras of multiple kingdoms and warlordism Chinese dynasties have ruled parts or all of China in some eras control stretched as far as Xinjiang and Tibet as at present Traditional culture and influences from other parts of Asia and the Western world carried by waves of immigration cultural assimilation expansion and foreign contact form the basis of the modern culture of China

Untitled Epic Poem on the History of Industrialization R. Buckminster Fuller, 1962
 Jonathan Williams and Fuller became friends at Black Mountain College in North Carolina in the 1930s Williams was delighted when in 1962 Fuller offered him a grant to help bring out this long poem in the Jargon Press series Williams knew nothing about the concurrent Simon and Schuster edition until some years later when he came across a copy in a bookstore Given Fuller's casual approach to the publishing process this kind of funny coincidence was not unusual Russell Davenport

was an editor at Fortune magazine during the period from 1938 to 1940 when Fuller was a consultant Davenport was later national campaign manager for Wendell Willkie in the Republican campaign of 1940 Almost buried on the back of the folded inside flap copy of the Jargon edition is Fuller s statement that he and Davenport closely collaborated on the Industrialization piece About 10 percent of the wording was Davenport s and neither of us ever hoped it would find a publisher In the introduction Davenport describes Fuller as not a poet in words but a poet in science and he had once described Fuller in Fortune as the first poet of industrialization Hugh Kenner has characterized this anthem to American industry as our only readable didactic poem Description by Ed Applewhite courtesy of The Estate of Buckminster Fuller [Forum](#) ,1988
