**Misunderstood Stories** Robert Karl Gnuse, 2014-03-20

Narratives in Genesis 1-11 have been misunderstood in many ways but they especially have been used to oppress women and African Americans and to present a God of wrath and judgment. This commentary seeks to explain the real message behind those narratives which is one that speaks of human dignity and equality that affirms monotheism that criticizes kings and tyrants that declares our oneness with the animal realm and nature and that proclaims a powerful message of divine grace with a deity personally involved in the human world. Humor may also be found in some of these stories. These biblical passages can be best explicated by close reading as well as by knowledge of comparable stories from the ancient Near East and from the classical world and finally by knowledge of the concomitant social and political values connected with those other myths and narratives.

**Two Arabic Travel Books** Abū Zayd al-Sīrāfi, Aḥmad ibn Faḍlān, 2014-12-08. Two Arabic Travel Books combines two exceptional exemplars of Arabic travel writing penned in the same era but chronicling wildly divergent experiences. *Accounts of China and India* is a compilation of reports and anecdotes on the lands and peoples of the Indian Ocean from the Somali headlands to China and Korea. The early centuries of the Abbasid era witnessed a substantial network of maritime trade, the real life background to the Sindbad tales. In this account we first travel east to discover a vivid human landscape including descriptions of Chinese society and government, Hindu religious practices and natural life from flying fish to Tibetan musk deer and Sri Lankan gems. The juxtaposed accounts create a jigsaw picture of a world not unlike our own, a world on the road to globalization. In its ports we find a priceless cargo of information: here are the first foreign descriptions of tea and porcelain, a panorama of unusual social practices, cannibal islands and Indian holy men, a marvelous mundane world contained in the compass of a novella. In *Mission to the Volga* we move north on a diplomatic mission from Baghdad to the upper reaches of the Volga River in what is now central Russia. This colorful documentary by Ibn Fadlan relates the trials and tribulations of an embassy of diplomats and missionaries sent by caliph al-Muqtadir to deliver political and religious instruction to the recently converted King of the Bulgars. During eleven months of grueling travel, Ibn Fadlan records the marvels he witnesses on his journey, including an aurora borealis and the white nights of the North. Crucially, he offers a description of the Viking Rus, including their customs, clothing, tattoos, and a striking account of a ship funeral. *Mission to the Volga* is also the earliest surviving instance of sustained first-person travel narrative in Arabic, a pioneering text of peerless historical and literary value. Together, the stories in *Two Arabic Travel Books* illuminate a vibrant world of diversity during the heyday of the Abbasid empire, narrated with as much curiosity and zeal as they were perceived by their observant beholders.
