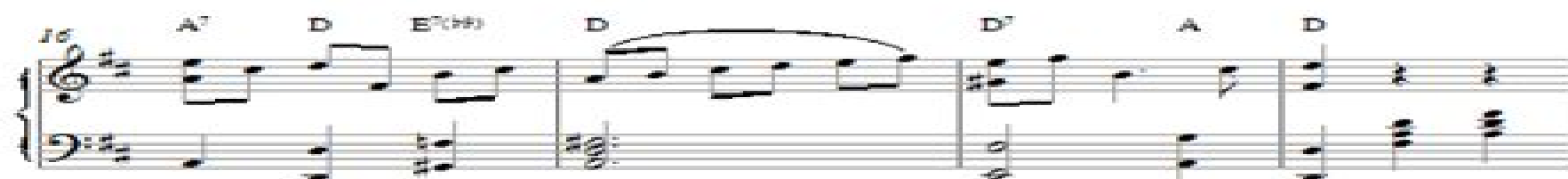
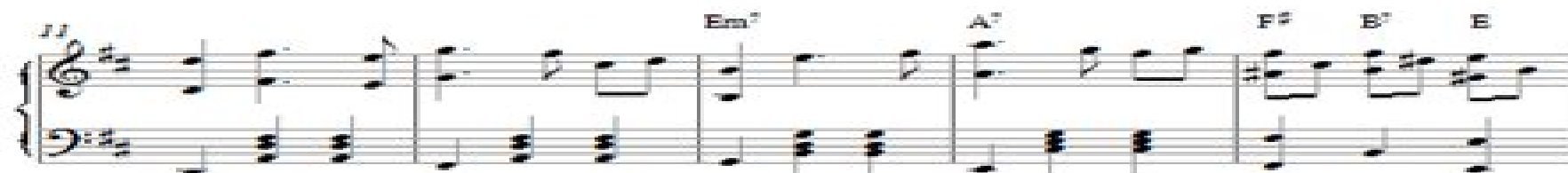

Classical Form William E.
