Germinie Lacerteux (French Classics) Edmond De Goncourt, 2015-01-06 In his will Edmond de Goncourt 1822 1896 left a bequest in honor of his brother Jules de Goncourt 1830 1870 to establish and support a French literary salon the Academie Goncourt and later the famous Prix Goncourt an award that to this day remains France's most significant literary prize The Goncourt brothers who co-authored a series of novels on social themes were among the founders of literary Naturalism in France Emile Zola would emerge as this movement's most important representative in his cycle of novels *Les Rougon Macquart* Among the novels co-written by the Goncourt brothers *Germinie Lacerteux* 1865 is especially noteworthy The double life of the novel's Parisian domestic servant who is ground down and destroyed by the conditions she lives in but who for decades keeps these conditions hidden from her employer continues to captivate book lovers in France and the rest of the world to this day

The Rougon-Macquart) Emile Zola, 2015-01-07 In The Downfall Zola tells the story of a terrific land slide which overwhelmed the French Second Empire It is a story of war grim and terrible of a struggle to the death between two great nations In it the author has put much of his finest work and the result is one of the masterpieces of literature The hero is Jean Macquart son of Antoine Macquart and brother of Gervaise After the terrible death of his wife as told in La Terre The Soil Jean enlisted for the second time in the army and went through the campaign up to the battle of Sedan After the capitulation he was made prisoner and in escaping was wounded When he returned to active service he took part in crushing the excesses of the Commune in Paris The Downfall has been described as a prose epic of modern war and vast though the subject be it is treated in a manner that is powerful painful and pathetic *Colas Breugnon* (A Burgundian Story; French Classics) Romain Rolland, 2015-01-06 Colas Breugnon is a charming romance of life in Burgundy three hundred years ago It is an autobiographical novel the story being told in the first person by Colas who reviews his fifty years of life and describes all its joys and sorrows The story is gay and humorous and full of wise observations about life Colas Breugnon is the jovial Burgundian the lusty wood carver the practical joker always fond of his glass the droll fellow Before everything Colas Breugnon is a free man He loves his king but only so long as the king leaves him his liberty he loves his wife but follows his own bent he is on excellent terms with the priest of a neighboring parish but never goes to church he idolizes his children but his vigorous individuality makes him unwilling to live with them He is friendly with all but subject to none he is freer than the king he has that sense of humor characteristic of the free spirit to whom the whole world belongs From the artistic point of view Colas Breugnon may perhaps be regarded as Rolland's most successful work This is because it is woven in one piece because it flows with a continuous rhythm because its progress is never arrested by the discussion of thorny problems It is written throughout in the same key The first sentence gives the note like a tuning fork and thence the entire book takes its pitch Throughout the same lively melody is sustained The writer employs a peculiarly happy form His style is poetic without being actually versified it has a melodious measure without being strictly metrical This work is unlike any of Rolland's other writings It is not an historic study a critical appreciation a philosophic essay nor yet even in the strictest sense of the word a novel It is rather a volume of reminiscences as told by a man of fifty and the very aimlessness with which this man talks is in itself a pleasure for Breugnon is himself the one subject of the book holding our attention by the display of a wayward sympathetic and aggressive personality Stefan Zweig

Swiss Reformation led by Ulrich Zwingli and at the beginning of the Anabaptist movement in Europe in the 16th century Gottfried Keller was one of the foremost Swiss novelists and one of the most original figures of German literature since Goethe a master of style worthy to be classed with the great names of all ages John Albrecht Walz The Trail of the Hawk Sinclair Lewis, 2015-01-07 The Trail of the Hawk by Sinclair Lewis is the chronicle of an inveterate Rolling Stone Carl Ericson a born rebel against conventions finds himself from boyhood up at war with the combined forces of family school and society all three of which unite in trying to mould him into the average colourless human being Consequently throughout his earlier years he is in perpetual disgrace at home at school and at college Thus it happens that we find Carl in early adolescence a friendless and penniless wanderer undaunted and thrilling with a sense of freedom and the boundless opportunity of satisfying his unquenchable curiosity about life The first of the three parts into which this chronicle is divided The Adventure of Youth covers the formative years and helps to explain why Carl is what he is and not otherwise Part II The Adventure of Adventuring is an undiluted joy It is improbable to be sure almost burlesque yet so joyous so spontaneous so kaleidoscopic in its varied scene and shifting action that one must accept it with indulgent credulity Packer in a department store waiter in a third class restaurant mechanic in an automobile factory chauffeur professional tramp and candidate for the bread line porter in a Bowery saloon facing the problem of saving four dollars out of a weekly salary of eight in order to gratify a new ambition namely to see the Panama Canal such is a brief epitome of one phase of our Rolling Stone's career a phase that all unconsciously is shaping him for bigger things and the following year finds him in California a partner in a profitable automobile repair shop Then the big news reaches him of the first successful flights of Curtis and the Wright Brothers and Carl recognises by instinct that here is the outlet for his pent up energies the one career for which his whole undisciplined nature has been crying out Much has been written about aviation both from the technical and the popular standpoint but it would be hard to find anywhere else in fiction any description that would give to the inexperienced a kindred thrill of breathless flight of danger that is a fearful joy and of confident omnipotence that is superhuman And then when this unrivalled Hawk of the Air men is at the zenith of his powers comes his third adventure The Adventure of Love Of course the inevitable happens the Hawk has his wings clipped flights are a thing of the past a confining although lucrative office position and a conventional apartment on the Upper West Side begin to prey upon his nerves and soon the happy couple are quarrelling acrimoniously and often But you cannot cage a hawk for long Frederic Taber Cooper The Trail of the Hawk is a truly lifelike chronicle of the fortunes of Widow Ericson's boy Carl of Joralemon Minn who becomes Hawk Ericson the daring aviator and marries a very nice girl indeed They had promised to find new horizons for each other and when the resources of a New York flat in the way of horizons are exhausted they sail for South America Atlantic Monthly *The Hunger Pastor* (German Classics) Wilhelm Raabe, 2015-01-07 Wilhelm Raabe's novel entitled Der Hungerpastor 1864 is a classic example of the so called poetic realism to which many primarily bourgeois German writers were devoted between 1850 and 1890

Wilhelm Raabe 1831 1910 became famous following the publication of his first novel *Die Chronik der Sperlingsgasse* The Sparrow Lane Chronicle in 1856 His late works are known for their social criticism while earlier novels such as *The Hunger Pastor* were intended to be primarily educational With the figure of Hans Unwirrsch in *The Hunger Pastor* Raabe completely lives up to his motto Look up to the stars Pay attention to the streets The budding pastor who was born into poverty hungers for knowledge and a respected place in society but he constantly stumbles over obstacles that his own life as well as the lives of his family and friends place before him Raabe's rambling style makes his works difficult reading for many contemporary readers In this version of *The Hunger Pastor* several chapters have therefore been summarized by the translator while the most important ones are published in their original length Despite some anti-Semitic elements which were commonly found in the works of some 19th century bourgeois writers in Germany *The Hunger Pastor* is and remains a German literature classic

Ghost Stories Rudyard Kipling, 2015-01-06 This is not exactly a book of downright ghost stories as the cover makes belief It is rather a collection of facts that never quite explained themselves All that the collector is certain of is that one man insisted upon dying because he believed himself to be haunted another man either made up a wonderful lie and stuck to it or visited a very strange place while the third man was indubitably crucified by some person or persons unknown and gave an extraordinary account of himself Rudyard Kipling The tales are quite as grisly as any one will demand although Mr Kipling makes fun of all of them and insinuates that they can be traced back to some variety of Indian fever or to the high spirits which are absorbed from bottles with popular labels N Y Herald

Gray (with an Essay by Jules Barbey D'Aureville) Oscar Wilde, 2015-01-06 Perhaps the book that created the most general discussion and criticism at this period was *The Picture of Dorian Gray* which appeared originally in Lippincott's Magazine in July 1890 as the complete novel for that issue. Wilde at first demurred on the ground that he had not tried his hand on a long and sustained story but finally gave his consent. The story seems to have simmered in his mind for some time though after he had once begun it it was quickly completed. Wilde has himself said that he wrote it in a few days. In a preface to this story written for a later edition in book form Mr Basil Ward the artist tells of the genesis of the story. It goes back to the year 1884 when Oscar Wilde was often in Mr Ward's studio. One of Mr Ward's sitters was a young man of such peculiar beauty that his friends had nicknamed him *The Radiant Youth*. Each afternoon Wilde watched the work advance enchanting everybody meanwhile with brilliant talk until at last the portrait was finished and its original had gone his way rejoicing without doubt to be at liberty. What a pity sighed Wilde that such a glorious creature should ever grow old. Yes it is indeed answered Mr Ward. How delightful it would be if Dorian could remain exactly as he is while the portrait aged and withered in his stead. I wish it might be so. And that was all I occupied myself says Mr Ward with the picture for perhaps a quarter of an hour during which Wilde smoked reflectively but uttered not one word. He arose presently and sauntered to the door merely nodding as he left the room. Jules Barbey d'Aureville

The Last Mistress Andrew Muir, 2011-03-02 *The Last Mistress* is the story of Richard Brown who leaves an English boarding school at the end of World War II to find his way in the world. Believing that he might have a vocation to take Holy Orders he decided to travel to Jerusalem and then onto Rome. A brief stay in Paris opens a new world to him. However as with his previous novels the author draws on his personal experiences and titillates us with descriptions of gastronomic delights and seductive and sensual pleasures of love.

Bug-Jargal (French Classics) Victor Hugo, 2015-01-06 *Bug Jargal* 1826 first published as a short story in 1819 is an early novel by French writer Victor Hugo 1802-1885. It describes the friendship between the enslaved African prince Bug Jargal and Leopold D'Auverney a French military officer during the slave revolt in Santo Domingo of August 1791 that would eventually lead to the creation of the republic of Haiti in 1804. Bug Jargal black slave and son of a king is a man of the noblest moral and intellectual character passionately in love with a white woman yet tempering the wildest passion with the deepest respect. There is no reader of the tale who can forget the entrancing interest of the scenes in

the camp of the insurgent chief Biassou or the death struggle between Habibrah and D Auverney upon the brink of the cataract The latter in particular is drawn with such intense force that the reader seems almost to be a witness of the changing fortunes of the fight and can hardly breathe freely till he comes to the close The Edinburgh Review
