- The stages of transcription are initiation, elongation, and termination. Draw a representation
 of each of these stages in a separate Word document. Be sure to include the names of
 important enzymes and locations.
- Once mRNA is created through transcription, it is often processed. Explain how mRNA can be processed. Include the names of important enzymes or structures.
- 3. Translation is how mRNA gets used to create a peptide sequence. Draw what is going on inside a ribosome. Be sure to include the locations of mRNA, tRNA, each subunit of the ribosome, and where the amino acid sequence forms.

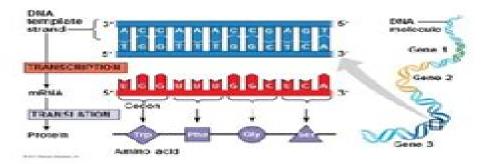


Figure 1. The Central Dogma of Molecular Genetics: DNA Codes for RNA, and RNA Codes for Protein.
