- Skinner's theory: Children learn the same way they learn everything else through imitation, reinforcements, conditioning, etc.
- Noam Chomsky's Theory: (piggybacking of skinner) Humans are biologically equipped to learn a language (Like how birds learn to fly) Also believes that language development is determined by biological maturation more than personal experience.
- > Navist Theory: A Language Acquisition Device (LAD) is an innate mechanism or process that facilitates the learning of language.
- Interactionist Theories: Experience and contributions important to the development of language. The human brain is wired to recognize sound patterns that makeup language. Social exchanges with parents and others are critical in molding language skills.
- Billingualism: This is the acquisition of two languages that use different speech sounds, vocabulary, and grammatical rules. (Nearly half the population is billingual).

Linguistic Relativity: The hypothesis that one's language determines the nature of one's thoughts. (Benjamin Lee Whorf a man advocate of this theory believes that different languages lead people to view the world differently).
