He was now faced with the inactivity created by the early retirement. But more importantly, his hard-earned career was now destroyed. Then two more tragedies strike. First, he contracts colon cancer but is apparently cured by an operation. But the final blow is unbearable to him. It is the death of his life-long love, his wife. Interwoven in the story is the devotion and love between him and his wife.
