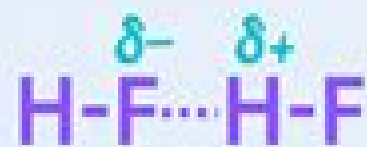

Intermolecular forces are attractive and repulsive forces between separate molecules.



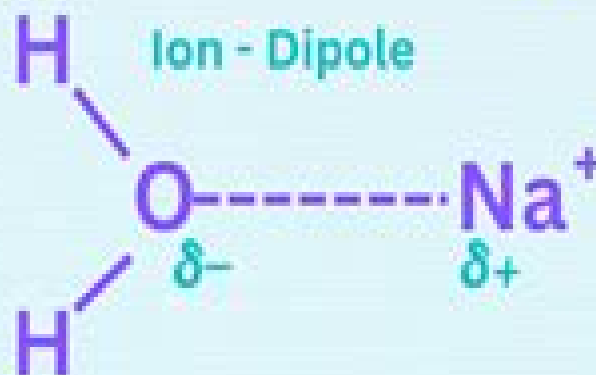
