Each chapter has subheadings so that students can scan the pages and identify important topics with little effort. Problems, references, and a glossary are found at the end of each chapter. Appendices at the end of the book provide useful reference material on various topics that support the text. This design allows students at different levels to easily navigate through the book and professors to assign pertinent sections in the order they prefer.
