CHANGE – WAR

Example 1 = Enslaved Persons during the Civil War ... read more in Unit 15 & 16!

THESES – "One group of Americans that was affected by United States participation in a war was enslaved persons during the Civil War"

TASK #1 – Slaves were considered property under the Dred Scott decision (1857). The Civil War broke out four years later; President Lincoln entered the war with the goal of preserving the Union, but he faced increasing pressure from abolitionists to end slavery as well. The Emancipation Proclamation abolished slavery, but only in the Southern states that had seceded (left the Union). After the Union victory, the 13th amendment banned slavery in all states. The 14th amendment granted citizenship and equal protection under the law to all people born in the U.S. The 15th amendment granted voting rights to men (women would wait until 1920)

TASK #2 – The first step towards political equality was made, but African-Americans still faced discrimination. After Reconstruction ended, Southern states passed "Jim Crow" laws to segregate public society. The sharecropping system tied former slaves to the land under a cycle of loans and debt, and laws like the black codes, literacy tests and poll taxes were used to limit African-American voting rights.

Example 2 = Japanese-Americans during World War II ... read more in Unit 26!

THESES – "Another group of Americans that was affected by U.S. involvement in a war was Japanese-Americans during World War II"

TASK #1 – The U.S.A. declared war on Japan after the bombing of Pearl Harbor, Hawaii. Suspensions increased after the attack and led to racist and prejudiced attitudes by whites towards Japanese-Americans. Japanese-Americans on the west coast were forced to move to over 10 different "relocation camps" under constant government supervision. They were not allowed to leave the camps until the end of WWII. Many Japanese-Americans actually fought in the U.S. military during WWII and were some of the highest-awarded soldiers in the military.

TASK #2 – The Supreme Court ruled that the forced relocation of Japanese-Americans was constitutional in *Korematsu vs. United States* (1944), stating that civil liberties may be limited during times of war. In 1988, the U.S. government apologized to Japanese-Americans for their treatment during WWII and made payments to the camp survivors. The Manzanar Camp in California, where over 100,000 Japanese-Americans were incarcerated, is now a national historic site to remember the past.
