A (AVPU) - Correct Answer-Alert. Will be able to maintain airway once clear.

V (AVPU) - Correct Answer-Verbal. Needs verbal stimuli to respond. (Airway adjunct may be needed to prevent tongue obstruction)

P (AVPU) - Correct Answer-Painful. Responds only to painful stimuli. (Airway adjunct may be needed while determining need for intubation)
