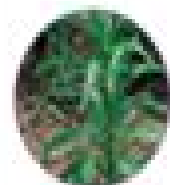

Spreading, alternating, elliptic to lance-shaped leaves



Bittercress, hairy
Cardamine hirsuta

Rosette leaves divided into eight to 16 leaflets



Canada thistle, common
Cirsium arvense

Strong, irregularly lobed leaves with spiny margins



Chickweed, common
Stellaria media

Dark green, alternating, egg-shaped leaves



Phytolacca, long-styled
Phytolacca tenella

The main stem does not have leaves, secondary stems contain flowers and leaves



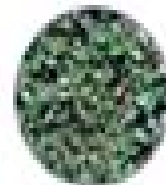
Pigweed, redroot
Amaranthus retrofractus

Leaves are linear with prominent midrib and reddish undersides



Hairybroom, bushy
Desmodium illinoense

Leaves are smooth and originate from a basal rosette; narrow, linear, elongated



Purslane, common
Portulaca oleraceus

Spoon-shaped leaves rounded at tip and narrowed at base



Eklipse
Eklipse prostrata

Small solitary flower heads; cylindrical, grayish roots



Oenothera
Oenothera perfoliata

Leaves are opposite with serrated leaflet margins



Groundsel, common
Senecio vulgaris

Leaves are pinnately lobed, alternating in direction along the length of the plant



Knotweed, prostrate
Polygonum aviculare

Smooth, blue-green leaves, sitting in linear-shaped



Lambquarters, common
Chenopodium album

Stemmed over to two leaf pairs and opposite; mature leaves are alternate



Hairybroom (bushy)
Desmodium illinoense

Young leaves are egg-shaped, arranged in a basal rosette



Mustard, wild
Sinapis arvensis

Leaves are oval-shaped, alternate, with stiff, bristly hairs on upper surface



Portulaca
Portulaca hysterophora

Narrow, alternate leaves arranged alternately

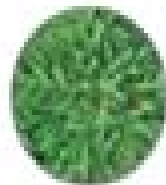
