- Keeping up to date with novel research in your field.
 Reviewing also gives you a glimpse of emerging research in your discipline, sometimes months before it is to be published.

It is becoming more common for researchers to use their review experience as evidence of their expertise when applying for funding or job applications, whether this is done informally or through validated reviewer recognition sites such as Publons.
