Sigmund Freud

Sigmund Freud was born in Vienna in 1856. He was the first born in his family which consisted of three boys and five girls. His father was strict, which was common in this time period, leaving him to often spend time with his mother, whom he felt was warm and kind. His family lived in a small apartment, however his family noticed his intelligence and made sure to foster his learning. He graduated from the university of Vienna at the age of 26 and obtained his medical degree. Four years later he became a lecturer at the university. Freud spent much of his life working on his theory, which he named psychonalysis. Freud often suffered from somatic complaints, phobias and the intense fear of dying. Freud invented the term self-analysis, which he would often perform himself to understand his fears and his unconscious. Freud became popular and is often viewed as the father of Psychology. He died in 1939 of cancer of the jaw.

To Freud, humans consist of impulses and drives. These impulses are often buried deep within us, some by which we do not even recognize. This is especially true of young children under the age of six. Freud coined the term **libido**, which consists of all the life energies of a person. The replacement theory is not another theory like the ones offered by the contemporary schools.
