The Hero of Babylon Charles Greeley Bellah, 1940 **The City of Babylon** Stephanie Dalley, 2021-07-08 Accessible and authoritative account of Babylon the city at the heart of one of the world's great civilisations **Babylon** Charles River Editors, 2025-05-02 The ancient world was full of many fantastic cities and places and like today's major cities the great ancient cities were hubs of trade religion and science Writing was first invented in ancient cities and many important scientific discoveries were also made in them some of which are still used in the modern world Among the many cities of the ancient world Rome and Athens may come to mind first but the city of Babylon in the land of Mesopotamia was already an ancient venerated city when the others were still inconsequential settlements Today Babylon has become a byword for greed excess and licentiousness mostly due to its mention in the Bible but a closer examination reveals that Babylon was so much more and even perhaps the most important city in the ancient world Ancient Babylon was home to great dynasties that produced some of the world's most influential leaders most notably Hammurabi and Nebuchadnezzar and these rulers invoked their wills on the entire ancient Near East and have been remembered as both progressive and cruel all at the same time Babylon was also the seat of culture in ancient Mesopotamia and the place where scholars made amazing scientific advances that would not be eclipsed for several centuries An examination of ancient Babylon demonstrates that it was truly the first great city in the ancient world Of course the sheer span of history between Babylon's power and today has produced plenty of historical questions and controversy One of the things people most closely associate Babylon with is the Hanging Gardens which like the Great Pyramid of Giza were considered both a technological marvel and an aesthetic masterpiece Ancient historians believed that the Hanging Gardens were constructed around the 7th century B C after the second rise of Babylon which would make them the second oldest of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World and they were reputedly created by the biblical Nebuchadnezzar II the king who conquered Judea to please his homesick wife after the model of Egyptian pleasure gardens However in 1993 British Assyriologist Stephanie Dalley proposed a theory that the Hanging Gardens were ordered built by the Assyrian King Sennacherib a century earlier for his giant palace at Nineveh instead She believed that the two sites were easily confused by ancient sources resulting in the Gardens being incorrectly located in Babylon a century later Babylon was also instrumental in the development of the region's religions Ancient Mesopotamian religion continues to captivate people for many of the same reasons today's best known religions and their histories fascinate people The religion practiced by the Ancient Mesopotamians provides a certain mix between the mundane and the surreal and at the same time aspects of it are both familiar and bizarre to people today Some find themselves drawn to it based on its preeminent position in religious history as the oldest documented religion in the world Others become fascinated with the close connections between some of the Mesopotamian religious texts which include a flood story a creation story and a story of the righteous sufferer and their parallels in the Hebrew Bible Today the Ancient Mesopotamians and their religion are a

source of curiosity but thousands of years ago the religion was an integral part of their lives From their birth to their death deities surrounded them and whether their social interactions were on the level of a smaller city or that of a larger nation state deities played key roles in the social fabric of their society In fact the people and religion were so intertwined that a study of Ancient Mesopotamian religion is a study of Ancient Mesopotamian culture *Ancient Anunnaki and the Babylonian Empire* Faruq Zamani, The earliest history of Babylon is little known Among the many cities flourishing in southern Iraq the town first appears in texts in the third millennium BC Until the last century of the third millennium few references existed to Babylon however offerings made to the temple of Enlil in Nippur during this period when Babylon was part of an empire ruled by Ur suggest a city already of some size and wealth From relative obscurity in the middle of the 18th century BC Babylon emerged as the political center of southern Mesopotamia It held this position almost continuously for the next 1 400 years Near Baghdad around 85 kilometers south of the Euphrates is the site of Babylon The area is located north of the great alluvial plain of southern Iraq a landscape of silts deposited by the Tigris and Euphrates into a vast rift created by tectonic movement as the Arabian plate slips beneath the neighboring Eurasian plate In addition to defining modern day Iraq's northern and eastern boundaries the Taurus and Zagros mountain ranges were created by the same collision As a result Mesopotamia encompasses several environmental zones but Babylon itself is found in the flat alluvial plain in southern Iraq In addition to containing one of the world's earliest cities³ the table is subject to several significant environmental constraints that have shaped human settlements since long before the foundation of Babylon Rain fed agriculture is beyond the reach of this area due to its high temperatures Despite the little precipitation this part of Iraq receives it is uneven and unreliable the bulk of a season's rain can fall in a single downpour damaging crops as severe droughts⁴ Human habitation is dependent on the two great rivers and the permanent settlement requires irrigation Upon establishment However on the levees of canals such a system could benefit from the rich alluvial soils and support highly productive agriculture In explaining the region's early urbanization and accompanying economic development many contend that the region's ability to produce large agricultural surpluses played a significant role though in what way is hotly contested Herodotus was undoubtedly impressed As a grain bearing country Assyria meaning Mesopotamia is the richest globally he writes in his description of the fifth century BC Figs grapes olives or other fruit trees are not grown there but the grain fields tend to produce crops two hundredfold and three hundredfold in exceptional years At least three inches wide are the wheat and barley blades Millet and sesame grow to an astonishing size as I know but those who have not visited Babylon have refused to believe even what I have already described as its fertility Sesame oil is the only oil they use and date palms most of which bear fruit provide them with food wine and honey
