NSFAS is a **government loan scheme**, with the added incentive of a bursary conversion (maximum of 40%) depending on academic performance.

- If you do well, 40% of this can be converted to a bursary!!
- If you fail, you will have to pay back EVERYTHING!
- Academically deserving and financially needy students have the opportunity to apply for a loan from NSFAS, part of which can be converted to a bursary, subject to academic results.
- Loans do not always cover tuition fees and other study costs in full. The amount of the loan is determined, among other things, by the family's financial need and the student's cost of study.
