the epidemic exacerbated class tensions Meanwhile conditions in France continued to be characterized by violence during the early 1830s as Louis Philippe attempted to establish his regime s authority The most significant of these uprisings was the republican dominated June Revolution of 1832 Victor Hugo and other contemporaries perceived the barricades of June as natural extensions of the cholera epidemic or the political continuation of a biological crisis.
