 - Biological Psychologists:
 - Analyze the biological factors influencing behavior & mental processing.
 - Personality Psychologists:
 - Study individuality & focus on people's unique characteristics
 - Developmental Psychologists:
 - Seek to understand, describe, & explore how behavior & mental processes change over the course of a lifetime.
 - Quantitative Psychologists:
 - Develop statistical methods evaluating & analyzing data from psychological research
 - Clinical & Counseling Psychologists:
 - Seek to asses, understand, & modify abnormal behavior
 - Community Psychologist:
 - Work to obtain psychological service for underserved client groups, & to prevent psychological disorder by working for changes in social systems.
 - Educational Psychologists:
 - Study methods by which instructor's teach & student's learn, & who apply their results to improving such methods.

 - Test IQ, diagnose student's academic problems, & set up


