## 1. A Simple Intro

Give people the information they need to relax and feel comfortable. Gently remind people to put mobile phones on silent and point out where the bathrooms are.

Take a moment to welcome first-time guests. Tell them you're glad they're here. Ask them to fill out a connect card and pop it in the offering basket as it passes.
