Be sure your documentation meets all EPSDT well child requirements. Thorough EPSDT well child documentation may help improve your P4P and HEDIS scores.

#### Psychosocial/Family History

Should be documented at every EPSDT and well child visit.

#### EXAMPLES:

- Primary residence: more grandparent, older brother. Support network: single parent. Assert of available community resources. Excelled in MAC. Preferred language: Spanish: Environmental no passive amois exposure."
- "PSHIPFM reviewed and undeted."
- "Perent adjustment to child: adjusting well, atting adjustment to child: adjusting well, children, in-home deposes.
  Sweek: Every of home with mare, died, staters (x2), and 2 cats. Smoking, ded amokes outside only."
- Tamily history reviewed—unremarkable; interacts well with peers; involved in school activities; perents involved with homework and know child's spois' circle. No signs of domestic violence or child realized mediant."

#### Structured Developmental Screening

"Development acreening at 9 max., 15 max., and 30 max. Autum acreening at 15 max, and 24 max. Herre of acreening tool used AND result should be documented at each EPSDT well (so indicated by age).

#### EXAMPLES:

- PSC completed WWL."
- "Development rennal for age—see Ages and Stages Questionnane in shart."
- "M-C/M7 completed-results reviewed with pt's grandmarker. First Steps referred."

#### Oregoing Developmental Surveillance

\*Developmental milestones should be documented at each EPSET and well child valt. A complete listing of developmental milestones or a statement similar to, 'all areas of development cornel for age,' reset both reental and physical developmental surveillance.

#### Depression Screening/ Risk Assessment

- "CRAFFT screening consisted- regative, PHO-8 consisted positive. Refer to behaviour health."
- ThEDADSSS completed PHID-2 negative. No betravioral concerns identified. No social ideation or depression symptoms identified."
- "Sitis?" completed— on concerns identified PHQ-9 negative. Hit re-screen in 3 months."
