In the first part of the book the author examines the scope and limits of our obligations to the dead. Our obligations to respect the wishes of the dead are more substantial than commonly acknowledged but they can be overridden in a range of cases when they conflict with the vital interests of the living such as in organ donation and wealth inheritance.
