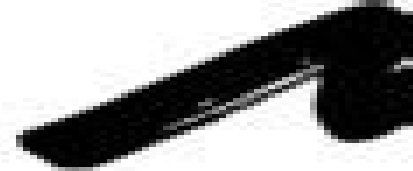

- She looks like such a wonderful figure and her **entire "gait"** puts her over (27)
- **People are open to the audience's perspective** but very close the audience respond emotionally but they also identify with the woman's point of view and find the emotions of the character
2. How do Pickering and Higgins differ with respect to women? There is a binary term we use to describe characters refer to the opposite of each other either as personality or manner, what is it?
- **Pickering seems to be polite and respectful** in the presence of women
- While **Higgins is impertinent women** just "as a child creature for never what is women to get anything out of her" (28)
- **Pickering seems to be kind to Higgins** as he is a gentleman and Higgins is brutal and insensitive
- **Higgins is not a character who connects with another character**, usually the protagonist, and, in an ironic, **Higgins makes fun of the main character's personality**
- It has two main important characteristics in contrast with the other character, such as, respectively, superficial traits or personal history.
