## Why I Write:

*Why I Write* George Orwell, 2021-01-01 George Orwell set out to make political writing into an art and to a wide extent this aim shaped the future of English literature his descriptions of authoritarian regimes helped to form a new vocabulary that is fundamental to understanding totalitarianism While 1984 and Animal Farm are amongst the most popular classic novels in the English language this new series of Orwell's essays seeks to bring a wider selection of his writing on politics and literature to a new readership In *Why I Write* the first in the Orwell's Essays series Orwell describes his journey to becoming a writer and his movement from writing poems to short stories to the essays fiction and non fiction we remember him for He also discusses what he sees as the four great motives for writing sheer egoism aesthetic enthusiasm historical impulse and political purpose and considers the importance of keeping these in balance *Why I Write* is a unique opportunity to look into Orwell's mind and it grants the reader an entirely different vantage point from which to consider the rest of the great writer's oeuvre

**Why I Write** George Orwell, 1946 *Why I Write* 1946 is an essay by George Orwell detailing his personal journey to becoming a writer It was first published in the Summer 1946 edition of *Gangrel* The editors of this magazine J B Pick and Charles Neil had asked a selection of writers to explain why they write The essay offers a type of mini autobiography in which he writes of having first completed poems and tried his hand at short stories and carried on a continuous story about himself in his head before finally becoming a full fledged writer It goes on to set out some important motives for writing

**Why I Write** George Orwell,2021 The essay Why I Write was originally published in the literary magazine Gangrel in the summer of 1946 Four years later on January 21 1950 its author the celebrated novelist and essayist George Orwell died of tuberculosis at University College Hospital in London Under UK copyright law the entire catalog of works published during Orwell s lifetime fell into the public domain in early 2021 On January 22 artist Louis Porter contacted Pooja Ahuja a New Delhi based translator and transcriber and commissioned her to handwrite Orwell s essay and send the pages to him in London
