Mein Kampf as a self description by Hitler 11 The term swastika never appears in the original Mein Kampf 12 There is no evidence that Hitler ever used the word swastika 13 The symbol that Hitler did use was intended to represent S letter shapes for socialist 14 Hitler altered his own signature to show his S shapes for socialism logo branding ALL HISTORIANS DID NOT SEE!
