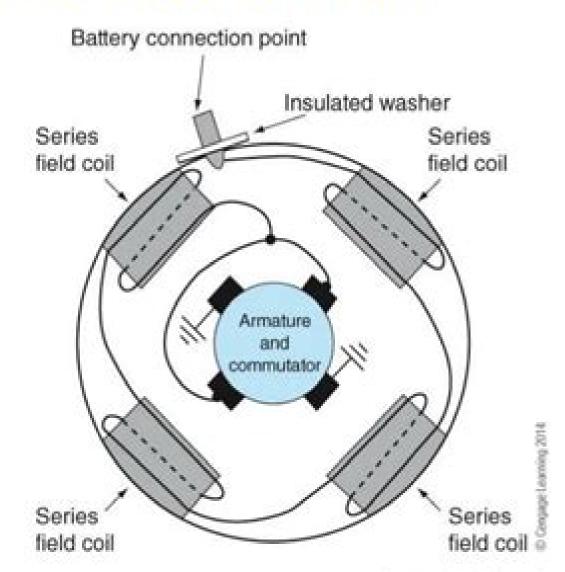


Figure 8-14 Series-wound motor.
