 - b. How many grams of rubidium fluoride will be produced from 4 moles of rubidium oxide?
 - c. How many grams of calcium fluoride would be required to produce 45.23 grams of rubidium fluoride?
 - d. How many grams of rubidium oxide are required to produce 12.24 moles of rubidium fluoride?
 - e. How many moles of calcium oxide will be produced from 1.25 moles of calcium fluoride?
