We expect that this volume will be of interest not just within but beyond the psychometric community In this volume experts in psychometrics machine learning artificial intelligence data science and natural language processing illustrate their work showing how the interdisciplinary expertise of each researcher blends into a coherent methodological framework to deal with complex data from complex virtual interfaces In the chapters focusing on methodologies the authors use real data examples to demonstrate how to implement the new methods in practice The corresponding programming codes in R and Python have been included as snippets in the book and are also available in fuller form in the GitHub code repository that accompanies the book **Technologies in Biomedical and Life Sciences Education** Harry J.
