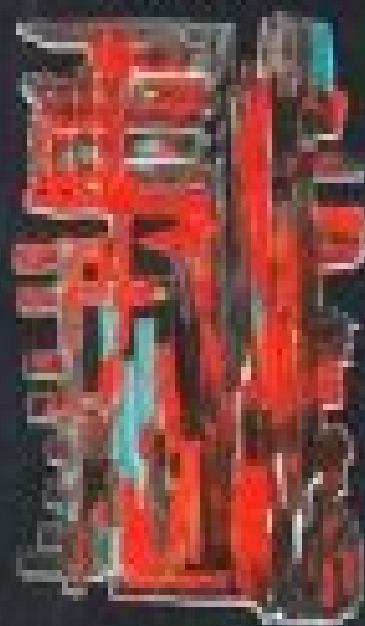

Zen Et Occident Jacques Brosse, 1999 Disciple du maître japonais Taisen Deshimaru Jacques Brosse fait partie de la première génération d'Européens qui ont tenté de présenter le message originel du zen leurs semblables en leur langue conformément leurs besoins et aspirations De cette expérience de vingt années d'enseignement est né ce livre de synthèse Avec enthousiasme et discernement Jacques Brosse souligne le caractère révolutionnaire du mode de pensée zen pour notre civilisation le mental perd la place prépondérante qui fut la sienne depuis si longtemps en Occident Introduit dans notre système intellectuel le zen pourrait bien y jouer le rôle thérapeutique qui fut le sien dès l'origine en proposant nos contemporains une philosophie intérieure résultant de l'expérience personnelle de la méditation *Japanese Buddhism in Europe*, 2025-07-24 Zen Shin and Soka Gakkai Japanese Buddhism has become part of the religious landscape in Europe with the presence of temples and centres thinkers and practitioners Since the opening of the country during the Meiji Restoration 1868 scholars and students went to European universities followed by migrants and missionaries rebuilding new forms of Buddhism For many decades poets artists and thinkers have been fascinated by Zen and its culture and religion have been incorporated into European forms Other schools of Japanese Buddhism have gained less popularity but nonetheless played a relevant role in the religious exchange between Japan and Europe This volume explores tendencies and perspectives of Japanese Buddhist denominations in various European countries through topics ranging from politics to poetry to issues related to ethnic religion and Christian interpretations of Buddhism Atlas et les territoires du regard Marina Vanci-Perahim, Catherine Wermester, 2006 *Thomas Merton en dialogue avec les religions d'Asie* Agnès Gros, Le moine trappiste franco-américain Thomas Merton 1915-1968 fut l'un des pionniers du dialogue entre christianisme et religions asiatiques Cet ouvrage présente son parcours culminant dans son voyage en Asie ses échanges avec des spirituels de diverses traditions qui ont influencé et enrichi sa vie spirituelle Face à l'expérience des Prés du désert et des mystiques chrétiens sa découverte du bouddhisme zen et tibétain du taoïsme et dans une moindre mesure de l'hindouisme ont transformé sa conception de l'être humain et de la vie intérieure L'autrice détaille ensuite la contribution de Thomas Merton à la théologie chrétienne des religions et le présente comme un pratiquant de la théologie comparative Des thèmes tels que la prière face à la méditation la non-dualité l'ouverture sur d'autres modes de relation au Divin l'élaboration d'un vocabulaire nouveau la notion d'intégration finale permettent de s'appuyer sur cette pensée foisonnante qui peut contribuer à enrichir la théologie chrétienne Les écrits de Thomas Merton sont une ressource précieuse pour entrer en dialogue avec les chercheurs d'Absolu qui interrogent aujourd'hui l'Eglise et le langage chrétien

Japanese Modernisation and Mingei Theory Yuko Kikuchi, 2004-07-31 Conceptualised in 1920s Japan by Yanagi Sōetsu the Mingei movement has spread world wide since the 1950s creating phenomena as diverse as Mingei museums Mingei connoisseurs and collectors Mingei shops and Mingei restaurants The theory at its core and its adaptation by Bernard Leach has long been an influential Oriental aesthetic for studio craft artists in the West But why did Mingei become so particularly
